This new book by Chris Musson is a celebration of the history, archaeology and landscapes of Radnorshire as seen from the air. The book is illustrated with numerous colour images which have been specially chosen to show how traces of the county's history, from the earliest times up to virtually the present day, are etched indelibly in the landscape.

Photographs in the book include the ceremonial monuments of pioneering Neolithic and Bronze Age farmers, the hillforts of Iron Age chieftains, strategic camps and forts built by the invading Roman army, Dark Age territorial boundaries, Norman motte-and-bailey castles, medieval towns, villages and churches, post-medieval lead mines, rabbit warrens and reservoirs as well as images of Radnorshire under winter snow.
